Privacy Policy

1. General

Robo Plast Quality Kft. – hereinafter referred to as Data Controller – respects the privacy of each person who visits <https://www.roboplastquality.com> website. Now we would like to inform you of the type of data collected by Data Controller and how they are used. You will also learn how you can exercise your data subjects' rights.

The Data Controller treats personal data confidentially and takes all security-, technical- and organizational measures that guarantee the security of the data.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to websites accessible via hyperlinks on Data Controller websites.

Definitions

Data Controller: any natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body which alone or jointly with others determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data.

Personal Data: any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (e.g. name, telephone number, online identifier, location data, portrait, voice, etc.).

2. Person of the Data Controller

For the purposes of these document, the following is considered to be the Data Controller:

3. Collection, use and processing of personal data

Data Controller uses personal data primarily to provide our website to the users. Any further processing of the data only occurs on the basis of other statutory duties or permissions or if the respective user has consented towards Data Controller.

The Data Controller stores and processes data specifically for the following purposes:

- When users visit the website, the Data Controller automatically collects and stores certain data. This includes: the IP address or device ID allocated to the respective end-device which we need for transmitting requested content (e.g. texts, and images as well as data files provided for downloading, etc.), the activity of users in the context of the website, the type of respective end-device, the used type of browser as well as the date and time of use.
- The Data Controller stores the data marked above for a maximum of 60 days from the date of their creation for the purpose of recognizing and pursuing misuse.
- The Data Controller uses this information also for improvements to the service's presentation, features and functionalities as well as general administration tasks.
- Aside from this, the Data Controller deletes or anonymizes the data on use, including the IP addresses, without undue delay as soon as they are no longer needed for the above mentioned purposes.

The processing and use of the data are based on statutory provisions which justify those operations on the grounds that:

- 1) the processing is necessary for the provision of the website;
- 2) the Data Controller has an overriding legitimate interest in ensuring and enhancing the functionality and error-free operation of the website and that it is tailored to the users' needs.

4. Further personal data processing

Contact form

You may have provided your contact data for the Data Controller via our contact form, or other possibilities too (e.g. e-mail, phone, or letter).

Scope of data managed:

- Name;
- Company name (*not required*);
- E-mail address;
- Phone number (*not required*).

The Data Controller will use your data for the purpose of replying to your request. The processing and use of your data are based on statutory provisions which justify those operations on the grounds that the processing is necessary for processing your request. The Data Controller stores your data until the 30th day following the case which is the subject of the ad hoc request.

If you have not given consent to a longer storage duration e.g. in the course of our stakeholder relationship management the Data Controller will store the data no longer than

needed in order to fulfil the aforementioned purpose or as long as required in case any statutory retention obligation applies.

5. Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small units of data temporarily stored on your computer or mobile device to increase your website experience. Cookies do not contain any personal information about you and cannot be used to identify an individual user. Some expire at the end of your website session; others remain on your computer for longer.

Types of cookies

First-party cookies: these cookies are set by the website you are visiting and they can only be read by that site.

Third-party cookies: these cookies are set by other organisations that we use for different services. For example, the Data Controller uses external Google reCAPTCHA service on the contact form, so the Google may set its own cookies on your browser for the website.

Handle cookies

If you wish to restrict or block cookies on the website, you can do this through your browser settings.

If you decide not to accept cookies, certain features of the website may not be displayed or may not work properly. This will restrict what you can do on the website and may have an impact on design and user experience.

Alternatively, you may wish to visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org/> which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers. You will also find details on how to delete cookies from your computer, as well as more general information about cookies.

Our cookies

Cookie consent (rpq_cookie_consent): This cookie stores info about a user's choice about cookies on this website.

Selected page language (rpq_language): This cookie stores info about the language of the currently selected page.

6. Your data subject rights

At any time, you may assert the right to access your data. Additionally, provided that the respective requirements are met, you may assert the following rights:

- Right to information
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure
- Right of access
- Right to restriction of processing
- Right to data portability
- Right to lodge a complaint with the respectively competent data protection supervisory authority
- Right to object

In case of processing activities involving your personal data that are carried out on basis of a legitimate interest of Data Controller, you have the right to object against such processing of your personal data at any time for reasons resulting from your specific situation. Data Controller will stop that processing unless Data Controller can prove important reasons for the processing which deserve protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or if the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend against legal claims.

You have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority responsible for us:
